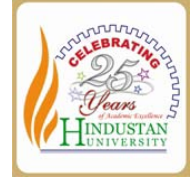

Every year we are conducting a Anti Ragging Day meeting by inviting Inspector General of Police or Commissioner of Police in the first week of August to address to the second year students on consequences and punishments under the Indian Criminal Law for ragging.
